Bennie Carl Pullin, born September 30, 1923 in San Antonio, went to be with the Lord on Wednesday, June 2, 2004. In his last days, he was surrounded and cared for by his family who loved him deeply.

Known as Carl by many, Bennie graduated from Brackenridge High School, served in the Army Air Corps during World War II, was a San Antonio Firefighter (as was his father and one of his sons, Mike Pullin) and was a member of Cibolo Valley Baptist Church. Bennie served the Fire Department for 26 years and until recently, there has been a Pullin in the San Antonio Fire Department for over 80 years.



He was preceded in death by his brother, John Charles Pullin; his sisters, Edith Wileen Pullin and Betty Jean Pullin Mazurek and his parents, Edith Cale Pullin and Bennie Lewis Pullin.
